# Volkshochschule Visit 23<sup>rd</sup> – 29<sup>th</sup> March 2013

A group of 22 residents from Offenburg visited Elstree & Borehamwood from the 23rd – 29th March. The trip was initiated by "Die Brücke" and Offenburg's Volkshochschule, a college for further adult education, and guided by Ralph Brunner, a German-Canadian who has been living in the Offenburg area for 30 years.

Before taking a very interesting and informative virtual tour of the town with Dave Armitage from the Elstree & Borehamwood Museum on Sunday morning, the German visitors were warmly welcomed by Martine Eni and Mayor Cllr. Charles Kelly at the Borehamwood Ibis Hotel. The afternoon was spent in St. Albans with a delegation of BETTA members. Special thanks to Nick Male, who guided the guests from Offenburg through St. Albans, the Abbey and the Verulamium Museum, and to Andrew and Erika Grady, Nigel Clark and Lynda Marshall.



The "Folk Evening" at the Cat and Fiddle Pub in Radlett on Wednesday was a real highlight. After being greeted by George MacGregor and his bagpipes, citizens from both towns enjoyed a wonderful evening of song, conversation and merriment. Many thanks to BETTA for your hospitality and to Roswetta Lamb for accompanying the German folk songs on her accordian. This is twinning at its best!



On Thursday morning, the Offenburg delegation was welcomed by Hertsmere Mayor Cllr. Pat Strack at the Hertsmere Civic Offices, after which Bob Redman from the Elstree Screen Heritage gave a presentation on the history of the studios. This was followed by a visit to the Elstree Studios, where the Managing Director Roger Morris received the German guests and gave insight into the relevance of Elstree & Borehamwood as a globallyrenowned studio town over the course of the past century. The morning ended with a guided film tour of the town by Nick Male.

The remainder of the time in England was spent touring and visiting many of the famous sights in Central London.

# **Club Escargot**

Our aim is to introduce children to the fun of learning French as early as possible, as well as discovering the culture and customs. The general ages of those attending the club are between 6 and 12 years old but this is flexible. The classes are held every Saturday during term time at St Paul's Church Hall, St Paul's Close, (corner of Cranes Way and Furzehill Road) each one is 2 hours long (from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m.). The classes cover the basics of the language (e.g. parts of the body, colours, numbers, positions, greetings, animals, clothes, transports, weather, etc.) through songs, rhymes, activities, cooking sessions, and traditional dances. The classes are run by qualified and fully trained teachers who have a lot of experience teaching children AND are all NATIVE FRENCH SPEAKERS. Children play, learn and are immersed in the French Language throughout the sessions. These activities actively help children with their communications skills and school progress. The adults who run the club are subjected to Enhanced C.R.B. checks, so you can drop the children off with the knowledge that they are in safe hands and go and have some much needed time alone!

### School Links Activities

Halfway through the school year, we are pleased to have put in place links between six schools in Borehamwood/Elstree and four schools in Fontenay. We have another pen pal exchange in the pipeline for this term.

The teachers sometimes keep in touch via email while the children exchange by post. They send something as a class, gathering cuttings about their schools or specific topics (sports, activities, outings, events, etc.), or write individually, introducing and speaking about themselves.

Artwork such as drawings, collages or cards for exceptional occasions such as The Diamond Jubilee and the Olympic Games last year and regular ones like Christmas, Easter, etc. can also be sent.

Depending on the respective level of the pupils in the two languages, the exchange is either in French or English but can even be in both! It can evolve as the pupils expand their knowledge. Above all, it is about exchanging and getting to know children from a different culture.

This is an exciting venture which has been welcomed with enthusiasm by our local schools, and we look forward to introducing the scheme to other schools.

School trips between our two countries could be planned. Some classes from Fontenay have already shown some interest in visiting Borehamwood/Elstree and, in so doing, possibly getting to meet their pen pal in person. To be continued...
