Offenburg School Flash visit of Elstree Studios for the day

The Association hosted a group of 65 students from Ernst Kästner Real-Schüle from Offenburg, the town's German Twin Town, when they dropped into Elstree Studios recently, whilst visiting London on a four day excursion.

Howard Berry, from The University of Hertfordshire gave a talk on the history of film making in Borehamwood. Within his short presentation he talked the group of 15/16 year olds through the life and history of the Film studios that existed in Borehamwood over the last 100 years. The Managing Director of Elstree Studios Roger Morris, welcomed the group to the studios, and talked briefly of the current activity of productions being made at the studios.

John Schoonraad, from Life-cast gave a short presentation, which enthralled the group. Life-cast make plaster casts prosthetics for use in films made at Elstree Studios. Following his presentation a number of the group were invited to his workshops to see how the things are made. The association organised a healthy lunch at the studios with the support of the Town Council of Elstree & Borehamwood

BETTA's very own Ambassador – Nigel Clark


