A lifelong interest for Deputy Mayor Lafon has been the code-breaking operation at Bletchley Park during the Second World War.

His particular hero is Alan Turing, portrayed so memorably by Benedict Cumberbatch in the recent film.

An outing to the museum now on the site was arranged for our guest and he was presented with a book about his hero.

From Offenburg - we welcomed Alfred Braun. Herr Braun is an active member Of ' Die Brücke ' which means ' The Bridge ', the sister organisation in Germany.
